Should pattern pieces be less than 5 pieces a minimum charge of R470.00 will apply.

Wash detail:

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Enzyme wash:

Biological enzymes are used in this wash to specifically target and remove excess starch that accumulated during the fabric weaving process. Biological enzymes catalyse the reaction between starch and the water solution optimising the removal of excess starch. Ideal for synthetic and natural fibres pre or post production.

Pre-Shrink Enzyme:

This wash is done at temperatures between 50 - 80 Degree Celsius. The wash consists of 4 parts to allow fibres to contract to max value and not shrink further.

Biological enzymes are used in this wash to specifically penetrate fabric fibres on high heat and lock fibres upon cold rinse Ideal for synthetic and natural fibres pre-production.

Fabric Softening NF - Intense

This wash lubricates and seals fabric fibers with a bio softening formula. The formula allows softening of natural and synthetic fabrics while maintaining fusing and interlining properties. This formula activates at 20-30 Degree Celsius making it ideal for post production washing.

Shrinkage Max

A natural formula is used on high temperatures to expand and contract fabric fibers to eliminate fabric shrinkage. Not recommended for natural fibers. Ideal for synthetic or elasticate based fabrics. Pre-production only.

Butter wash

Introducing a new and innovative formula using biodegradable ingredients and a fluctuating heat process to penetrate fabric fibers. Post treatment the fabric feels super soft and lustrous. Ideal for natural and synthetic fabrics pre-production or post production.
